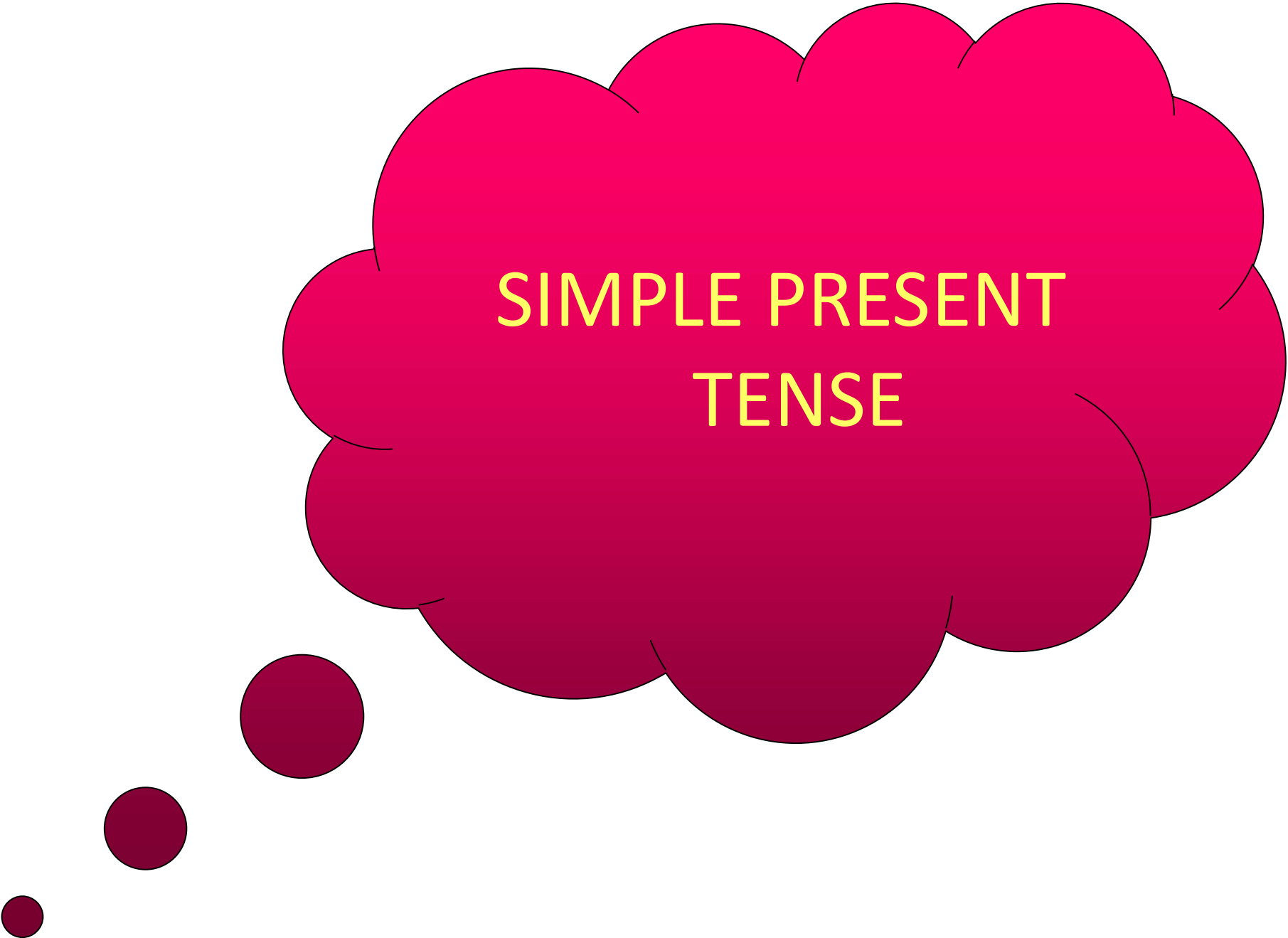
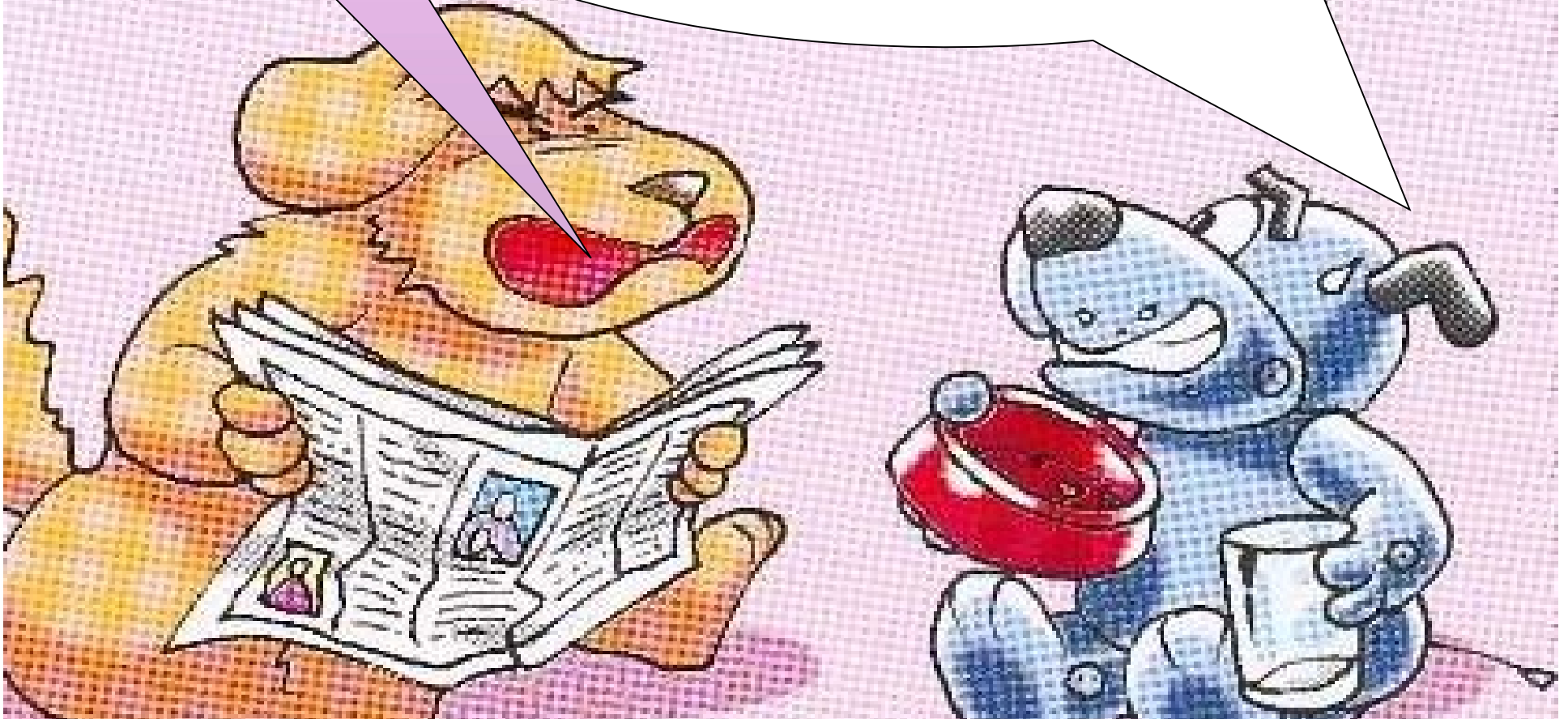




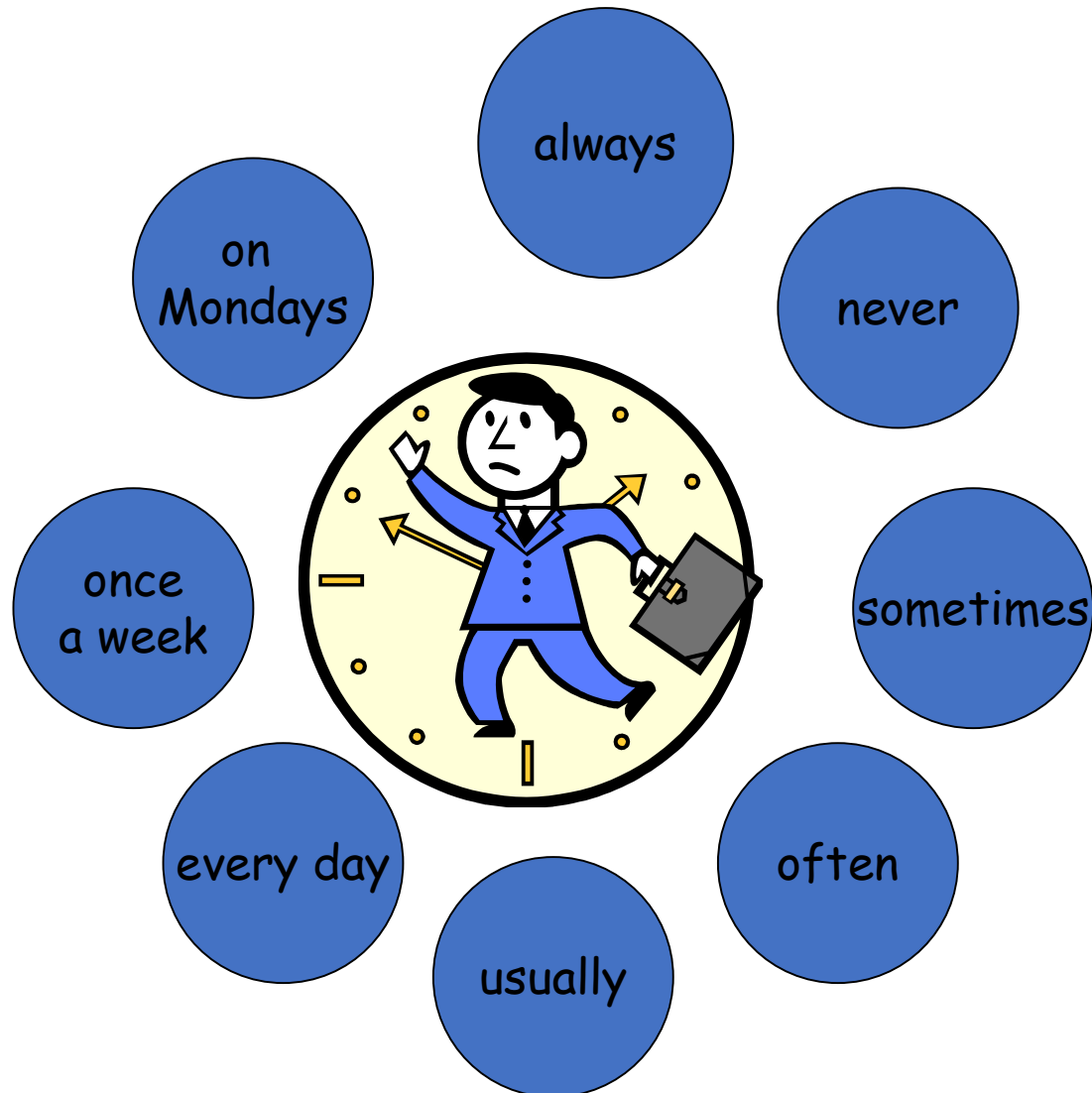

There are some more examples.



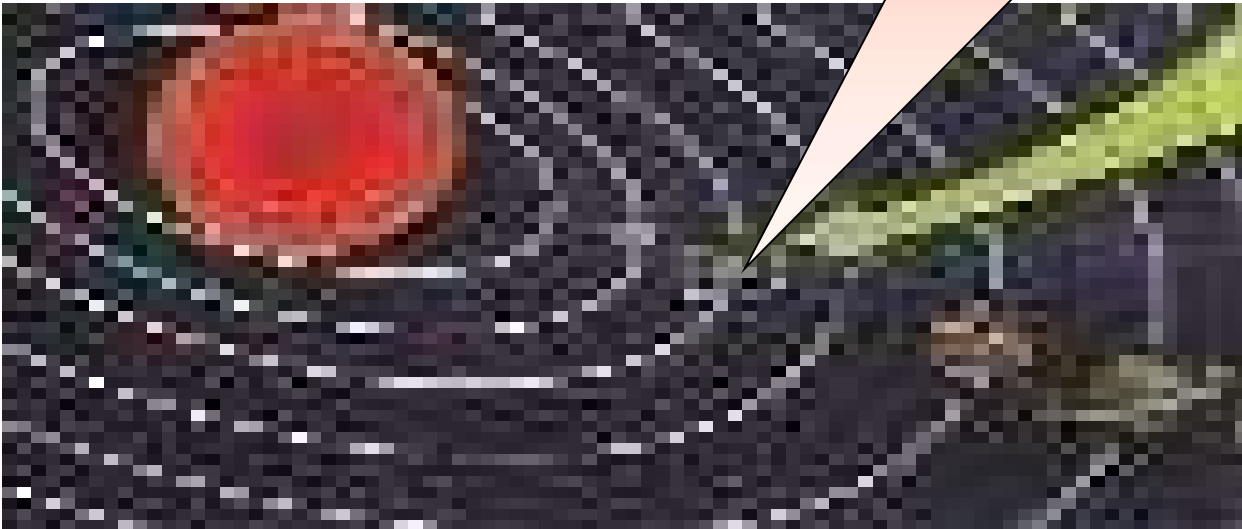

Cats eats fish.

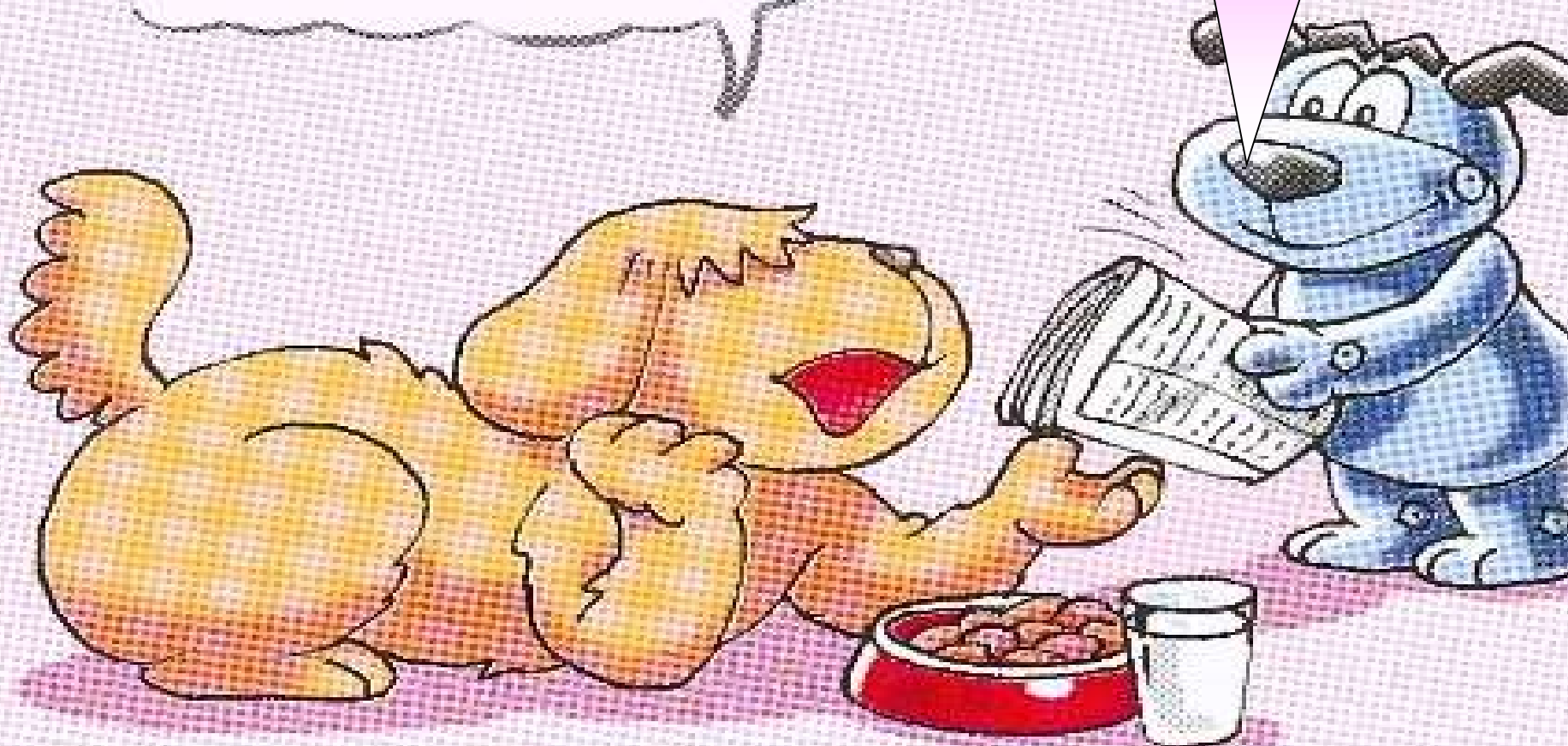
