SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE

Course Description

This course provides students with knowledge of English tenses. It aims to explore twelve English tenses, to make students learn how to differentiate each tense, to develop students' skill in verb patterns and sentence structures, to allow students identify various kinds of tenses, to allow students use various kinds of sentences, to allow students do various practices, and to allow students make, evaluate and develop written and oral expressions using correct and appropriate verb patterns.

Course Learning Outcomes

At the successful completion of this topic, students will be able to:

1. define what simple future tense is
2. classify the verb patterns of simple future tense
3. demonstrate the simple future tense in both oral and written forms
4. differentiate various uses of simple future tense
5. argue when and why the simple future tense is used
6. develop their own sentences by using their own words in both oral and written forms

Simple Future Tense adalah *tense* yang digunakan untuk menerangkan peristiwa/kegiatan yang akan dilakukan di masa depan atau di waktu yang akan datang. Dalam Bahasa Indonesia, *tense* ini dimaknai *akan*.

Rumus Verbal:

Kalimat Positif : S + **will/shall** + V1

Kalimat Negatif : S + **will/shall** + **not** + V1

Kalimat Interogatif : **Will/shall** + S + V1?

Contoh Kalimat Verbal

Positif	She/He/It/Temon They/We/I/You	will go to Bali next week.	
		will read the books tomorrow.	
Negatif	She/He/It/Temon They/We/I/You	will not go to Bali next week.	
		will not read the books tomorrow.	
Interogatif	Will	she/he/it/Temon/They/We/I/You	go to Bali next week?
			read the books tomorrow?

Rumus Nominal:

Kalimat Positif : **S + will/shall+ be + Kata Sifat/Kata Benda/Kata Keterangan**

Kalimat Negatif : **S + will/shall + not + be + Kata Sifat/Kata Benda/Kata Keterangan**

Kalimat Interogatif : **will/shall + S + be + Kata Sifat/Kata Benda/Kata Keterangan?**

Contoh Kalimat Nominal

Positif	She/He/It/Temon They/We/I/You	will be here tomorrow.	
		will tell the students about the project next month.	
Negatif	She/He/It/Temon They/We/I/You	will not be here tomorrow.	
		will not tell the students about the project next month.	

Interogatif	Will	she/he/it/Temon They/We/I/You	be here tomorrow?
			tell the students about the project next month?

Catatan!

Berikut adalah beberapa penanda waktu/*time signals* yang digunakan dalam *Simple Future Tense*.

Tomorrow	: Besok
The day after tomorrow	: Besok lusa
Next week	: Minggu depan
Next month	: Bulan depan

Shall digunakan untuk subjek *I* dan *We*, namun jika *shall* disandingkan dengan subjek selain *I* dan *We*, maka maknanya akan menjadi *harus* dan bukan merupakan makna *simple future tense*. *Shall* tidak lazim digunakan dalam Bahasa Inggris Amerika, *shall* umumnya digunakan dalam Bahasa Inggris *British*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.

- ✓ I shall go to Bandar Lampung tomorrow.
- ✓ We shall not forget them.

Will not dapat disingkat menjadi *won't*.

Shall not dapat disingkat menjadi *shan't*.

WILL vs. BE GOING TO

Selain bentuk *will*, *be (is/am/are) going to* juga digunakan untuk menyatakan perbuatan/tindakan yang akan dilakukan di masa mendatang. Bentuk *will* digunakan untuk peristiwa atau tindakan yang tidak terencana, spontan, dan jika suatu kondisi tertentu terpenuhi, sedangkan *be (is/am/are) going to* digunakan untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan yang telah terencana atau pasti dilakukan di masa mendatang.

- ✓ Untuk menyatakan suatu prediksi di masa yang akan datang, bisa menggunakan *will* ataupun *be (is/am/are) going to*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.
 - According to the weather forecast, it *will* be stormy tomorrow. ATAU
 - According to the weather forecast, it *is going to* be stormy tomorrow.
- ✓ Untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan yang terencana, gunakan *be (is/am/are) going to*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.
 - A: Are you busy tonight?
 - B: Yes, I am. I *am going to* meet Sarah at 8 tonight. *We're going to* have dinner with some friends.
- ✓ Untuk menyatakan suatu kesediaan, gunakan *will*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.
 - A: I don't understand about the questions.
 - B: No worry, I *will* help you.

Penggunaan *Simple Future Tense*

1. untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan yang akan dilakukan pada masa yang akan datang namun tidak direncanakan. Keputusan diambil secara spontan saat pembicaraan berlangsung.
 - Just be quiet! I'll get some milk for you!
 - Maybe I will just stay in and watch television.

Pada contoh di atas, tidak ada rencana pasti sebelum diucapkan. Keputusan dibuat saat pembicaraan berlangsung. Biasanya, *simple future tense* ini juga digunakan dengan kata kerja *think*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.

- I think I will buy a book tomorrow.
 - I don't think I'll go to the beach tomorrow.
2. untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan prediksi yang akan dilakukan pada masa yang akan datang. Namun, lagi dan lagi tidak ada rencana pasti. Kita hanya menyatakan apa yang kita kira sepertinya akan terjadi atau lakukan.
 - I will give you some money tomorrow.
 - It will rain tomorrow.

Ketika kita menggunakan *be* setelah *will*, kita bisa menggunakan simple future tense meskipun kita sudah memiliki rencana pasti atau keputusan sebelum berbicara.

- I will be in Bandar Lampung tomorrow.
- Just stay here. I am going to get some help. I won't be long.

- If you go with me, I will give you a good novel.
- I will cry if you go.

FUTURE PROGRESSIVE/CONTINUOUS TENSE

Future Progressive/Continuous Tense adalah *tense* yang digunakan untuk menyatakan peristiwa yang akan sedang berlangsung pada waktu tertentu di masa depan.

Rumus Verbal:

Kalimat Positif : S + **will/shall** + **be** + **Ving**

Kalimat Negatif : S + **will/shall** + **not** + **be** + **Ving**

Kalimat Interogatif : **Will/shall** + S+ **be** + **Ving?**

Contoh Kalimat Verbal

Positif	She/He/It/Temon	will be working at 11 tonight.	
	They/We/I/You	will be taking the bus to work at 6.30 tomorrow.	

Negatif	She/He/It/Temon	will not be working at 11 tonight.	
	They/We/I/You	will not be taking the bus to work at 6.30 tomorrow.	
Interogatif	Will	She/He/It/Temon They/We/I/You	be working at 11 tonight?
			be taking the bus to work at 6.30 tomorrow?

Penggunaan *Future Progressive/Continuous Tense*

- untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa yang akan sedang berlangsung di masa depan dalam suatu titik waktu tertentu.
 - She will begin to study at 7.30. You will call her at 08.00. She will be studying when you call.
 - Right now, she is travelling to Malaysia. At the same time next month, she will be travelling to Malaysia.
- untuk menanyakan informasi secara sopan yang akan dilakukan pada masa mendatang dan dalam kalimat interogatif/pertanyaan.
 - Will Sarah be coming with us to the party?
 - Will you be inviting your girlfriend to come tonight?
- untuk menyatakan peristiwa atau tindakan yang sudah terjadi sekarang dan masih terjadi pada masa mendatang dengan menyisipkan kata keterangan *still* (masih).
 - In two hours, I will still be waiting for you.
 - He will still be suffering from his cold tomorrow.

Catatan!

Bentuk *progressive/continuous* dari *be going to* adalah *be going to + be + Ving*. Perhatikan contoh berikut.

- Don't call me at 11 because I won't be at home. I *am going to be discussing* my project with some friends.

Future progressive/continuous tense dan *simple future tense* terkadang hampir tidak ada perbedaan dalam penggunaannya terutama jika peristiwa yang akan dilakukan tidak diketahui kepastian spesifik waktunya. Perhatikan contoh berikut.

- Don't worry. He *will be coming* soon.
- Don't worry. He *will come* soon.

Kata keterangan waktu yang menunjukkan masa lampau yang sering digunakan dalam *future progressive/continuous tense* diantaranya adalah:

- At 9 o'clock tomorrow : jam 9 besok
- At this time tomorrow : pada waktu ini besok
- At the same time next month : pada waktu yang sama bulan depan

Future Perfect Tense adalah *tense* yang digunakan untuk menerangkan peristiwa/kegiatan yang sudah dimulai pada masa lampau dan akan selesai di waktu yang akan datang. Dalam Bahasa Indonesia, *tense* ini dimaknai *akan sudah*.

Rumus Verbal:

- Kalimat Positif : S + **will/shall** + **have** + V3
- Kalimat Negatif : S + **will/shall** + **not** + **have** + V3
- Kalimat Interogatif : **Will/shall** + S + **have** + V3

Penggunaan *Future Perfect Tense*

- untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan yang akan sudah selesai di waktu tertentu pada masa yang akan datang.
 - Sarah will have finished her project at 11 p.m.
 - I will have read these books at 9 p.m.
- untuk menyatakan suatu peristiwa atau tindakan yang akan sudah terjadi dan selesai sebelum peristiwa atau tindakan lain terjadi.
 - I will have finished cooking by the time you arrive.
 - They will have gone to school before you arrive.

Perhatikan contoh lainnya sebagai berikut.

- The train will leave the station at 8 a.m.
- You will arrive at the station at 8.20 a.m.

Maka, berdasarkan kalimat-kalimat di atas, bentuk *future perfect tense*-nya menjadi:

- When you arrive, the train *will have left*.

Future Perfect Progressive/Continuous Tense adalah tense yang digunakan untuk menerangkan peristiwa/kegiatan yang sudah dimulai pada masa lampau dan akan selesai di waktu yang akan datang. Dalam Bahasa Indonesia, tense ini dimaknai *akan sudah sedang*. Penggunaannya hampir sama dengan *future perfect*, namun *future perfect progressive/continuous tense* ini menyatakan tindakan atau keadaan yang durasinya lebih lama hingga titik waktu tertentu di masa yang akan datang.

Rumus Verbal:

Kalimat Positif	: S + will/shall + have + been + Ving
Kalimat Negatif	: S + will/shall + not + have + been + Ving
Kalimat Interogatif	: Will/shall + S + have + been + Ving?
